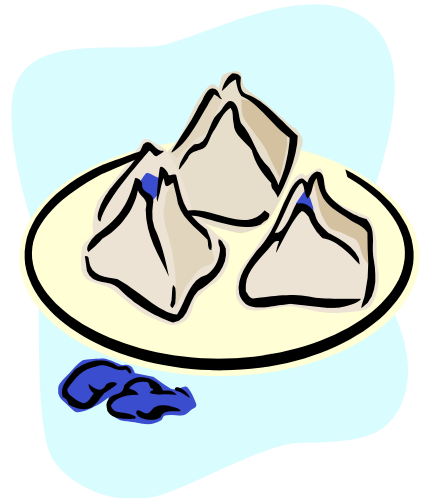
Purim Names Song
