- 10:32 AM latest time for eating <u>hametz</u>
- 11:49 AM latest time for burning *hametz*.
- 7:13 PM 1st candle lighting. Blessing *l'hadlik ner shel yom tov*; followed by *shehehiyanu*.
- 1:04 AM "midnight"; afikoman should be eaten by then

Thursday, April 6th, Pesah 1, Yom Tov.

- 9:30 AM services, in person and on livestream, including Hallel, Shir HaShirim, Tal
- 7:14 Candles for 2nd Yom Tov are lit from an existing flame, such as a yahrzeit candle; Blessing *l'hadlik ner shel yom tov*; followed by *shehehiyanu*.
- First Omer count at seder; after this count omer every night after dark.
- 1:05 AM "midnight"; afikoman should be eaten by then

Friday, April 7th, Pesah 2, Yom Tov.

- 9:30 AM services, in person and on livestream Hallel, Shir HaShirim; Torah, Musaf.
- 5:45 PM Shabbat and Festival services in the Goodman Chapel and on livestream.
- 7:16 PM. Light Shabbat candles from an existing flame before this time.

Shabbat, April 8th, Pesah 3, Shabbat Hol HaMoed Pesah

- 9:30 AM services, in person and on livestream Hallel, Shir HaShirim; Torah, Musaf.
- 8:18 Havdalah. Recite the usual havdalah like after every shabbat.

Sunday, April 9th, Pesah 4 Hol HaMoed.

Monday April 10th. Pesah 5 Hol HaMoed

- 7:21 PM Candle lighting for the second night, from an existing flame. Blessing *l'hadlik ner shel shabbat v'shel yom tov*. **No** *shehe<u>h</u>iyanu* blessing.

Thursday, April 13rd, Pesah 8 Yom Tov

- 7:30 AM Festival service in person and on livestream, including Hallel, *Shir HaShirim;* Torah, *Yizkor. Musaf*
- 8:24 PM Festival ends. *Havdalah* is recited at home, with wine and final brakhah, no spices and no candle.
- 9:30 PM Hametz may again be eaten.
